



## 2010 CENSUS: IT'S IN OUR HANDS

About the Census Form  
10 questions. 10 minutes.

Every question asked on the 2010 Census Form is for a specific reason, to ensure response accuracy or to determine seats in Congress.

*Note: The Census Form cannot be filled out online.*

The 2010 Census Form is just 10 questions, such as:

- Name
- Sex
- Age
- Date of Birth
- Hispanic Origin
- Race
- Household Relationship
- If you own or rent

The census DOES NOT ask about the legal status of respondents or their Social Security numbers.

The mailing package from the Census Bureau consists of:

- 10 question form
- A postage-paid envelope

US Postal Service workers will deliver the initial mailing in mid-March 2010. In areas not served by the USPS, census takers will deliver form packages.

Any request for census information from the Census Bureau will be clearly identified as coming from the U.S. Census Bureau and as OFFICIAL BUSINESS of the United States. It is a federal offense for anyone to pretend they represent the Census Bureau. Before your household receives a mailed form, a phone call or a visit from the Census Bureau, you will be given a few days notice with a letter from the Census Bureau Director.
