PART TIME REFUSE SERVICE WORKER

General Statement of Duties: Under general supervision of Waste Management Supervisor.

Essential Functions and Responsibilities:

The following duty statements are not intended and should not be interpreted as an exhaustive list of all responsibilities and skills associated with this position. Other duties and responsibilities are performed as assigned.

- Performs duties as assigned by Waste Management Supervisor.
- Operates the Trash Truck as directed.
- Performs collection of refuse material as directed.
- Performs disposal of refuse material as directed.
- Performs other duties as assigned.
- May be asked to work an occasional weekend.

Job Requirements:

Ability to deal with the general public and fellow workers in a cordial and professional manner.

Ability to use and learn the proper use of equipment.

Ability to follow complex oral and written directions.

Ability to maintain basic records on work activities, work schedule.

The employee shall work well under pressure, meet multiple and sometimes competing deadlines.

The employee shall at all times demonstrate cooperative behavior with colleagues and supervisors.

Physical Demand Requirements and Work Environment:

This job's physical demand requirements place the position in the **Heavy** rating category according to the U.S. Department of Labor's Dictionary of Occupational Titles, Volume II, Fourth Edition, Revised 1991.

DOT Frequency: Occasional (1%-33%), Frequent (34%-66%), Constant (67%-100%)

Requires crawling and kneeling occasionally.

Requires standing, walking, sitting, climbing, squatting, stooping, carrying, overhead reaching, angular reaching, wrist flexion/extension, elbow flexion/extension, supination/pronation and grasping constantly.

Must be able to overhead pull 15 pounds to 10 inches frequently.

Must be able to push ½ of 200 pound dumpster 15 ft. in a 2 man push frequently.

Must be able to climb a 17.5 inch step frequently.

Must be able to carry with one hand: push stick, shovel, various small pieces of debris and various hand tools frequently.

Must be able to carry with both hands: 61 pounds to 22 ft. occasionally.

Must be able to lift 61 pounds from 38 inches to 48 inches occasionally.

Maximum lift is 61 pounds.

Exposed to outdoor weather conditions, temperature changes, wet or humid conditions not related to weather, noise, confined spaces, fumes/dust/dirt, upper body/whole body vibrations, sharp tools, slick flooring, and forceful exertions.

Ability to perform in adverse weather.
